



## The National Medical Student Voter Registration Campaign Guide

1. Look up your state's voter registration [deadline](#)<sup>1</sup>.
2. Browse the [Brennan Center Student Voting Guide](#)<sup>2</sup> to learn specifics about voting as a student in your state.
3. Contact the relevant person in your school's administration to set up a voter registration/information booth. If you aren't able to set up an actual booth, send an email to all students with information about deadlines and how to register (and possibly follow up reminder emails).
4. Use this link to find out where/how to [register to vote](#)<sup>3</sup> in your state. It's different for each state. Some states can register directly online (in which case you can have a laptop open at the voter registration table for students to register at that time) while other states need a simple form filled out (in which case you can print multiple and hand them out to students, maybe even get the administration to donate postage so you can offer to mail the registration form in for them).
5. Encourage students to know where their [polling place](#)<sup>4</sup> is.
6. Each state has different processes for voter registration, but the above links should make it clear for you fairly quickly. We are also sending three documents for you to use as you see helpful: 1. The Election Season Prep document, 2. A template for a state-specific document that can be customized, and 3. A Voter Registration/Information sign that you can print out for your table.
